

ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK

Feedback is the vital component for effective learning. It helps to improve the academic standards of the students and teachers by giving them clear guidance on how to improve their learning and teaching methods.

The college has an effective system for collecting and analyzing the feedback of students, teachers, parents and alumni regarding teaching, learning process, employment prospects of the curriculum, infrastructure and its cleanliness etc.

After collecting feedbacks proper analysis of the results is carried out to identify the gap between **the actual and the expected outcomes**. This analysis is then looked into by the **IQAC** to identify suitable measures to be taken to improve performance on continuous basis.

The analysis shows that teacher's opinion regarding various statements stated above is very satisfactory. The mean scores of all these components are nearly 3 which suggest that the teachers agree with curriculum being taught to the students and it also develops work culture among teachers and students. Most of the teachers strongly believe that the "adoption of new teaching techniques such as seminar, group discussion, and use of smart classrooms are important components to make teaching more effective.

The overall opinion of 3.22 suggests that the current practices in the college are satisfactory.

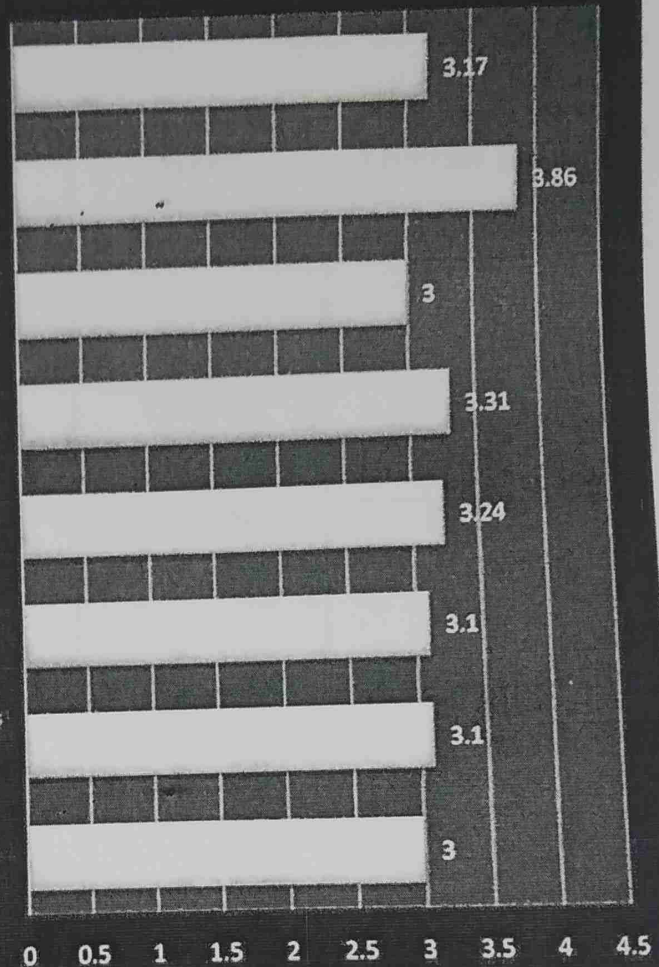


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Feedback from students

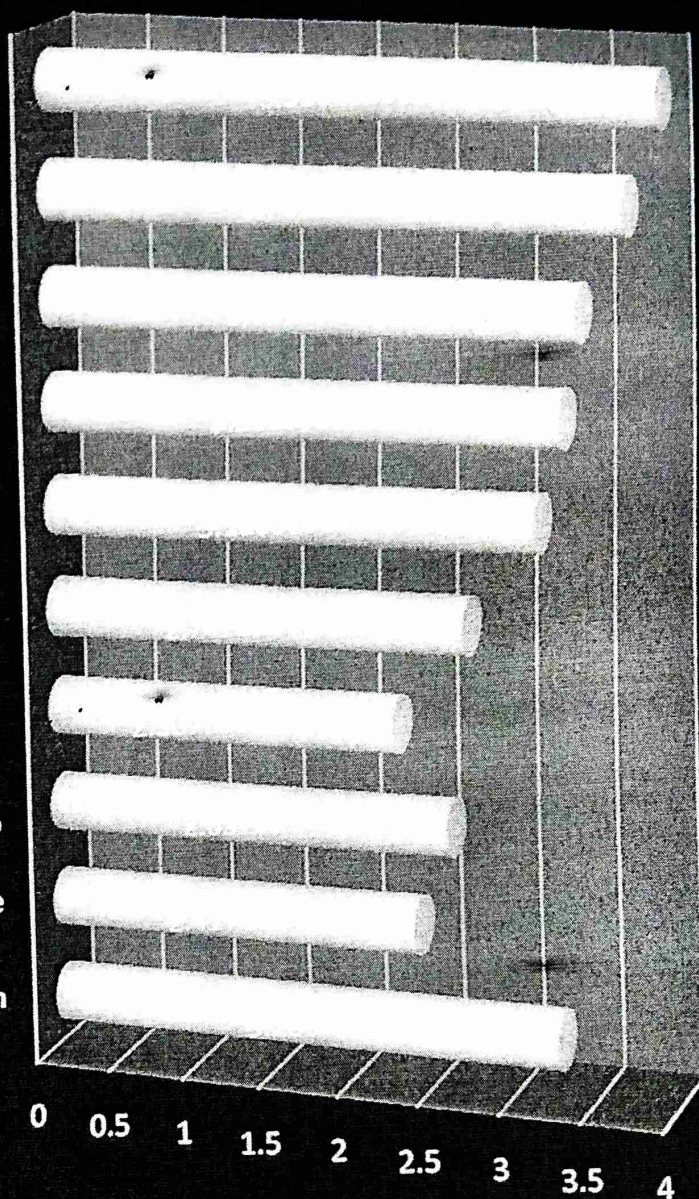

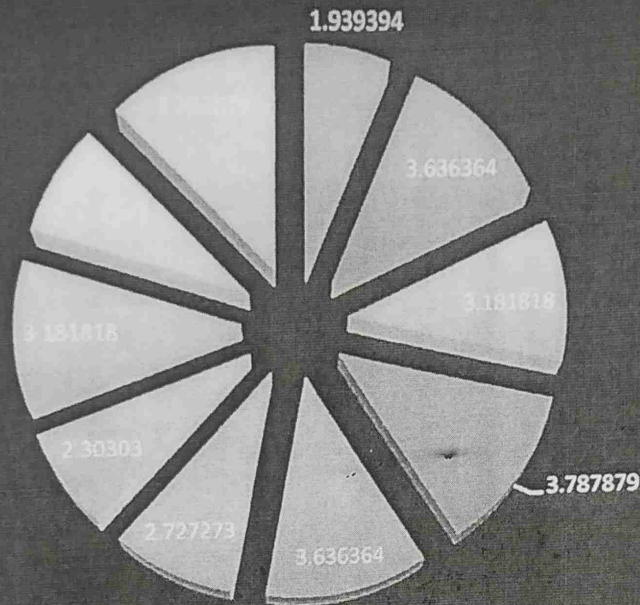
1. **The course curriculum met your aspirations for employment** - this particular domain needs to be taken care of. As in some faculties curriculum has not been updated since long time. So, students are facing problem in getting employment.
2. **The syllabus inculcated an interest to pursue higher studies** – analysis shows that 3.636364 out of 4 students agree that they go for higher education.
3. **The course curriculum enhanced your logical and critical ability**- 3.181818 students agree that the curriculum enhanced there logical and critical ability.
4. **There is need to introduce skill based syllabus into curriculum and Smart classes are essential for transfer of knowledge** – students strongly feel that that there is high need to introduce skill based syllabus into curriculum and smart classes and other innovative modes of teaching should be given due importance to make teaching-learning more effective.
5. **The course curriculum has remained helpful in preparation for the various competitive exams**- students agree that that topic of competitive exams are included in their curriculum but still some changes need to be made to the curriculum in some faculties.
6. **The course curriculum has prepared you to face daily life challenges** – there is a disagreement in this particular domain also as only 2.30303 out of 4 agrees that this aspiration is met by the curriculum.
7. **The prescribed curriculum helped in your personality development**- Alumni partly agrees that curriculum has enhanced there personality as a whole.
8. **You are satisfied with your internal assessment** – students feel although the system of internal assessment is fair but there is some problem in the criteria of assessment.
