APRIL:-Basics of Enzymology: Discovery and nomenclature; characteristics of enzymes; concept of holoenzyme, apoenzyme, coenzyme and co-factors; regulation of enzyme activity; mechanism of action.

Growth and development: Definitions, phases of growth and development; Plant hormones- auxins, gibberellins, cytokinins, abscissic acid and ethylene, history of their discovery, mechanism of action; photo-morphogenesis; phytochromes and their discovery, physiological role and mechanism of action.

MAY :- Lipid metabolism: Structure and functions of lipids; fatty acid biosynthesis; B-oxidation; saturated and unsaturated fatty acids; storage and mobilization of fatty acids.

Genetic engineering and Biotechnology: Tools and techniques of recombinant DNA technology; cloning vectors; genomic and cDNA library; transposable elements; aspects of plant tissue culture; cellular totipotency, differentiation and morphogenesis; biology of Agrobacterium; vectors for gene delivery and marker genes.

JUNE :- Origin, distribution, botanical description, brief idea of cultivation and uses of the following

Food plants- Cereals (Rice, Wheat and Maize).

Pulses- (Gram, Arhar and Pea). **Vegetables-** (Potato, Tomato and Onion). **Fibers-** Cotton.

Jute and Flax.

Oils- Groundnut, Mustard and Coconut.

Morphology of plant part used, brief idea of cultivation and uses of the following:

Spices- Coriander, Ferula, Ginger, Turmeric, Cloves.

Medicinal Plants- *Cinchona*, *Rauwolfia*, *Atropa*, *Opium*, *Cannabis*, Neem.

Botanical description and processing of:

Beverages- Tea and Coffee.

Rubber- *Hevea*.

Salient features of the systems of classification of angiosperms proposed by Bentham & Hooker and Engler & Prantl.
Diversity of Flowering Plants: Diagnostic features and economic importance of the following families: Ranunculaceae, Brassicaceae, Malvaceae, Euphorbiaceae, Rutaceae, Leguminosae, Apiaceae, Asclepiadaceae, Lamiaceae, Solanaceae, Asteraceae, Liliaceae and Poaceae.

MAY:- Flower-a modified shoot; functions of various floral parts. Microsporangium, its wall and dehiscence mechanism.
Microsporogenesis, pollen grains and its structure (pollen wall). Pollen-pistil interaction; self incompatibility.
Pollination (types and agencies); pollen germination (microgametogenesis). Male gametophyte.
